The working process is automated and very easy.

The clean, wet cutlery is loaded into the cutlery drying and polishing machine POLISTAR KK 8000 VED and goes a helical way in a vibration bulk, which is filled with a pure vegetal product.

This granulate which is always at a constant warm temperature enables to dry and to polish the cutlery. The humidity absorbed by the granulate evaporates as well.

After a short period of time the cutlery comes out perfectly dry and shiny - no matter if it is silver or steel.

The radiation of an integrated UVC lamp sterilizes constantly the surface of both the cutlery and the drying granulate.
